The Cherry Hills Village Joint Public Safety Building is owned and operated by South Metro Fire Rescue Authority and Cherry Hills Village as Joint Tenants in Common. The design and construction of the building were performed under an Intergovernmental Agreement (IGA) between the two entities.

The Building includes a Community/Training Room, Offices, 3 Apparatus Bays, 7 Bedrooms, Holding Cells, and Living Quarters for the Firefighters.
