**SUBJECT:** PETITIONING

The City of Englewood has placed restrictions on petitioning.

Attached you will find a copy of the City Manager's Petitioning Policy dated August 2, 2000 and the letter from EEF President Rick Kahm dated March 5, 2015. Please note that "City owned facilities" includes Pirates Cove Aquatic Center.

Also, the Policy states that "petitioners may only petition on private property with the owner's permission". The Englewood Environmental Foundation (EEF) owns all the common areas of the development from South Santa Fe to South Elati Street and U.S. 285 to Floyd Avenue, along with the north parking lot (RTD lot), with the exception of the Walmart and Chuck E. Cheese parking lots.

The light rail platform itself belongs to RTD. The bridge is owned by EEF.

If the owner of a business, in the area owned by EEF, gives you permission to petition inside their business that is their choice, but once you step out of the business you cannot petition.

Petitioning is allowed in the City parks.


The Englewood Environmental Foundation (EEF) owns and manages all of the common areas of the CityCenter Englewood development from South Santa Fe Drive to South Elati Street, and from U.S. 285 to Floyd Avenue, as well as the north RTD parking lot; the Wal-Mart and Chuck E. Cheese parking lots are not included.

EEF only allows petitioning in the designated Petition/Campaign Area, as noted on the attached map. The petitioner must secure a permit. The security guards have a standing order to stop any petitioning that has not been approved per permit. This includes Civic Center and the CityCenter Amphitheater.

It is the choice of any business owner in this development to give you permission to petition *inside* their business.



Terms and Conditions

- Petitioning/Campaigning is allowed in the areas designated on the attached map. Additionally, petitioning is allowed on sidewalks located within the Public Right-of-Way surrounding CityCenter Englewood (S. Elati St. and Hampden Ave.). Interior roadways, including the Englewood Parkway are private and subject to EEFI Terms and Conditions.
- City/Center Englewood is a mixed use development that includes residential use. Petitioning is allowed between the hours of 7:00 AM and 9:00 PM.
- Permit holder shall have a copy of the executed permit for inspection by EEFI representatives and Security.
- Littering, producing excessive noise, disrupting the established uses of other persons and entities that have historically and properly used and enjoyed EEFI property may result in the immediate cancellation of this permit.
- The use of amplified sound is prohibited.
- Electrical power is not provided by EEFI. Portable power equipment (small generators), supplied by the applicant, require pre-approval by EEFI.

I have received, read, understand, fully agree and accept the Terms and Conditions. I understand that EEFI may require up to 48 hours to process the application. Permits will be issued between the hours of 8:00 AM and 5:00 PM, Monday-Friday only.
