Englewood City Council
Study Session
Monday, September 26, 2011

Roll Call.

Present were Mayor Jim Woodward, Mayor Pro Tem Jill Wilson, Council Members Rick Gillit, Joe Jefferson, Bob McCaslin, Linda Olson and Randy Penn. Also present were Deputy City Manager Mike Flaherty and City Attorney Dan Brotzman.

I. Medical Marijuana Residential Regulations

▶ At 6:10 p.m. in the Community Room, Financial and Administrative Services Director Frank Gryglewicz and Deputy City Clerk Kerry Bush discussed the medical marijuana residential regulations. Discussion ensued. Legislation will be forthcoming.

II. October 12th Public Forum Discussion

▶ City Council discussed the format for the public forum on parking and storage of recreational and off-road vehicles on Wednesday, October 12, 2011. Discussion ensued. The meeting was defined and will begin at 7:00 p.m. with the informational boards available at 6:30 p.m.
