Overview and Goals

- Project began in April 2011
- Funded through a “Communities Putting Prevention to Work” grant from Tri-County Health
 - Grant includes money for plan development and for implementation
- Focus is on immediately implementable improvements to the on-street bicycle system
- Goal is to develop a comprehensive and understandable on-street bicycle route system

General Project Information

The City of Englewood Community Development Department was recently awarded a Communities Rubbing Presentation to Work (CPRW) planning grant funded by the County Health Department for the existing bicycling improvement planning project. The grant of the CPRW grant funding is to support community planning efforts to study bicycling active daily living safety in order to present a comprehensive plan for the Englewood Master Bicycle Plan. The grant funding will be used to support the following activities: a detailed study of potential on-street bicycle routes, as well as additional funds to pay for immediate initiatives such as new route signing, enhanced pavement marking and intersection signing, and new public bicycle parking racks throughout the community.

Planning Considerations

- Multiple east/west and north/south route options are desirable
- Connect to local destinations in Englewood
- Connect to border jurisdiction facilities
- Overcome barriers such as Hampden Ave and Belleview Ave
- Provide understandable user guidance through consistent signage and mapping
- Minimize maintenance and operations costs



Proposed Bicycle System

- Existing Bicycle Routes 11.0 miles
- Proposed Bicycle Routes
 - Miles of Regional Routes 14.6 Miles
 - Miles of Local Routes 7.7 Miles
 - Total Miles Proposed Bicycle Routes 22.3 Miles

This results in a 103% increase in bicycle routes in Englewood

- Comprehensive and Understandable Route Mapping
