 - **Impacts of Sequestration (CDBG & COPS Grant)**

CDBG: While we know that federal spending will be reduced, we respectfully request that this not be done in a disproportionate manner to the interests of cities and towns.
 - **Water/Wastewater Regulations**

Another area of serious concern is the reduction to the water and wastewater state revolving fund. President Obama proposes a 27 percent reduction in this program. This is a critical component to helping cities and towns comply with EPA standards, where in Colorado we have a \$4.5 billion need.
 - **Transportation and Transit**

Municipal officials believe that the adequacy of a multimodal statewide transportation system is vital to Colorado's economy. We appreciate previous work done by the state's Congressional delegation on SAFTEA-LU and ISTEA. Municipal leaders will continue to work with you to increase funding levels for Colorado.
 - **Public Safety Communications**

We encourage your support of legislation like H.R. 607 which will strengthen the communication capabilities of first responders by reallocating the D Block communications spectrum to police and fire agencies.
